There are a number of reasons for playing softball from just having outdoor fun with friends to being competitive against other state teams, to wanting to play softball at a higher level after graduating high school. It will be structured under Homer Mariner Softball, Inc- a local organization that also supports the Homer High program The philosophies of the high school program will be in effect for all levels of the summer program. Basically, we adhere to the tenets of the Positive Coaching Alliance where we expect players to embrace effort, learning and mastery and if you fail to then re-evaluate and try to fail better the next time. We appreciate that softball has a high level of skill that is needed for an entry level of fun and will work to make that process as smooth as possible.

Teams will be age structured-based on the number and skill of players.. At this time there is no firm schedule but we plan to play once a weekday evening against Kenai, alternating here and there. We also plan to play in an Anchorage Tournament June 18/19, Birchwood Jamboree July 16/17, State Tournament in Anc July 23/24. We are hoping to co-host a tournament in Kenai June 25/26. Tournament teams may be an age specific combination of our Homer and Kenai teams, depending on numbers. Registration fee is \$100 but does not include the cost of any travel, lodging or food associated with that travel. We are happy to provide loaner gloves, cleats, bats, etc for those that want to experience softball prior to making purchases. With the switch to USA/Softball as the governing body for summer softball we will rely on parental support for field work, umpiring, coaching, chaperoning, travel, etc. We are happy to provide training in all these fields.
